Business Studies

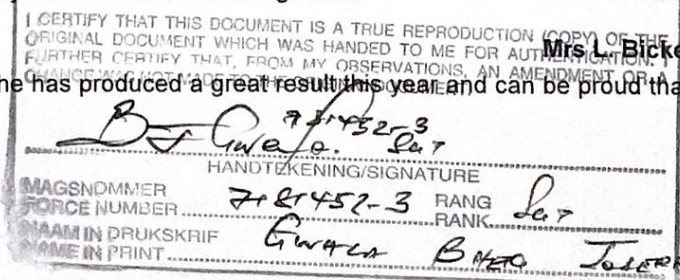
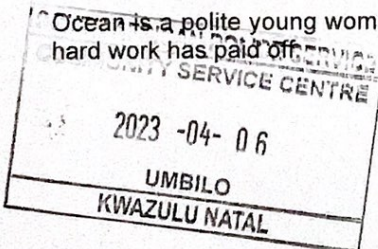
